



Study Abroad + Community Engagement

THE PROGRAM

As part of the full-time study load during your semester abroad, you’ll enroll in one of our academic units that embeds a community engagement opportunity as part of the curriculum. Our Program Coordinator will suggest an academic unit that matches your study plan. Examples of our academic units are:

Featured Placement: Kicking Goals Together (KGT)

KGT provides a 16-week soccer tournament during semesters 1 and 2, which includes players from refugee and migrant backgrounds, as well as international student cohorts.

Student roles in the program include assisting with the organisation and delivery of the KGT soccer tournament, assisting with the Skill Up (job skills) and English language (Aussie English Unpacked) programs where relevant, and helping to create a positive and welcoming environment for participants. There will also be an expectation to attend some planning meetings.
