Recommended:

The Arts: Complete ONE of the following combinations:

- EDAR241 + EDAR342
- EDAR241 + EDAR290
- EDAR342 + EDAR290
- EDAR290 + (EDAR310 or EDAR311 or EDAR312).

Health and Physical Education: Complete ONE of the following combinations:

- EDPH241 + EDPH342
- EDPH241 + EDHP290
- EDPH342 + EDHP290
- EDHP290 + (EDHP310 or EDHP311 or EDHP312 or EDHP313).

Science: Complete ONE of the following combinations:

- EDST241 + EDST342
- EDST241 + EDSI290
- EDST342 + EDSI290
- EDSI290 + (EDSI410 or EDSI411).

NOTE: Where students complete one unit from the pre-2021 program, and one from the post-2021 program, SOME duplication of content may occur, however students must complete the WHOLE of BOTH units.

Where there are incompatible units and/or pre-requisites listed, these may need to be formally waived. Waiver requests are assessed on a case-by-case: please submit an application for a waiver of the incompatible / pre-requisite via Student Connect.
