## **Dolly's Summer Dress**

This basic pattern is designed to be made up with 8ply wool and 4mm needles.

## **Dress body**

- 1. Cast on 96 stitches
- 2. Rows 1-46: Work every row in purl
- 3. Row 47: Knit 3 stitches together continuously across the row giving you 32 stitches.
- 4. Rows 1-46: Work every row in purl
- 5. Rows 48-72: Work every row in plain (you might like to do this in stripes)
- 6. Row 73: Cast off

## **Neckline and backstops**

- 1. Cast on 12 stitches
- 2. Rows 1-60: knit every row
- 3. Cast off

## To finish the dress

- 1. Sew up the back seam of dress
- 2. Fold the long strip in half to find the middle
- 3. Measure 4-5cm either side of that middle point to form the front neckline
- 4. Sew that 8-10cm to the front of the dress
- 5. Cross the straps at back of dress and sew into place
- 6. Trim the dress as desired

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
