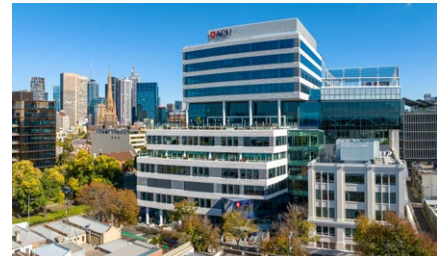

Our academics are renowned for their high-quality teaching, industry connections, and world-class research. Meet a current academic from each of our four faculties below.



ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR RACHEL DRYER

Associate Professor Rachel Dryer is the Head of Discipline, Psychology and the Indigenous Perspective Coordinator in the School of Behavioural and Health Sciences at ACU's Strathfield Campus. She is a registered psychologist whose research and teaching expertise are in psychological assessment, health psychology, women's perinatal and postnatal wellbeing, and wellbeing of students with disability in higher education.

Associate Professor Dryer employs both quantitative and qualitative research methodologies in her work and is published in leading international journals. She has also

authored and co-authored several book chapters, and her book *Pregnancy-related anxiety: Theory, research, and practice* was published as part of the Routledge Series in Women's Mental Health. This book examines theoretical, empirical and methodological perspectives regarding pregnancy-related anxiety. She and her research colleagues have also developed the Pregnancy-related Anxiety Scale (PrAS), a psychometrically sound psychological screening test that has now been translated and adapted for use in Germany, Indonesia, Turkey and Ghana.



PROFESSOR MARY RYAN

Professor Mary Ryan is the Professor and Executive Dean of the Faculty of Education and Arts at ACU. She is a past president of the New South Wales Council of Deans of Education and Chair of the Education Research Council for Australian Independent Schools New South Wales. She is a Principal Fellow of the UK Higher Education Academy and is the recipient of a national citation for outstanding contributions to student learning.

Professor Ryan has led Australian Research Council (ARC)-funded projects in classroom writing and preparing reflexive teachers for diverse classrooms. Her research is in the areas

of writing pedagogy and assessment, reflexive writing, teachers' work and professional learning, the enabling and constraining conditions for graduating students to manage the demands of their profession, and reflexive learning and practice.

Professor Ryan has an extensive record of program development, having coordinated undergraduate, postgraduate and higher degree research programs. She regularly provides advice to ministers of education and early childhood across multiple states, as well as to regulatory authorities in education and the Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership.



PROFESSOR ANDREW O'NEIL

Professor Andrew O'Neil is Professor and Executive Dean of the Faculty of Law and Business at ACU. Immediately prior to taking up this role in January 2023, he was Acting Dean of the Graduate Research School and Professor of Political Science at Griffith University. Before entering academia in 2000, and directly after completing his PhD, Andrew worked for Australia's Department of Defence.

Professor O'Neil is the author and co-author of several books and has published his research in a wide variety of scholarly and policy-oriented outlets. Working in teams, he has received

competitive grants from multiple funding agencies, including the ARC, for projects examining Indo-Pacific security and geopolitics.

Professor O'Neil has also held external appointments including membership of the ARC College of Experts, TEQSA's Register of Experts, Terrorism (High Risk Offenders) at NSW Department of Communities and Justice, and Chair of the Australian Business Deans Council Research Network. He is currently a Partner Investigator on the ARC's Centre of Excellence for the Elimination of Violence Against Women.



PROFESSOR ROBYN HORNER

Professor Robyn Horner is a teaching and research academic within the School of Theology, and a member of the Institute for Religion and Critical Inquiry (IRCI) at ACU. From 2010 – 2015, she held the position of Associate Dean (Learning and Teaching) of the Faculty of Theology and Philosophy.

Formerly a teacher in Catholic primary and secondary schools and a liturgical musician and composer, she has two main areas of theological

research expertise. First, she investigates theological questions in ways that speak in and to the contemporary context, using hermeneutic phenomenology and poststructuralism. Second, she has expertise in the theology of recontextualisation and the promotion of the Catholic dialogue school. This is fundamental to her teaching and to the research translation she undertakes in consultancies around Australia.

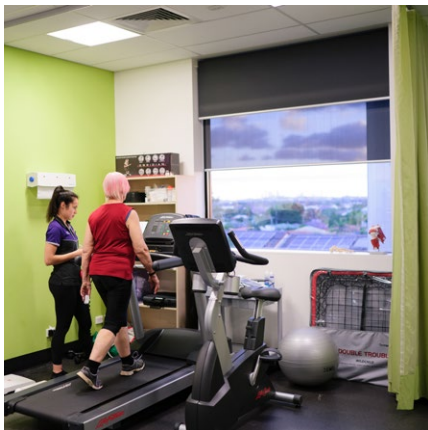

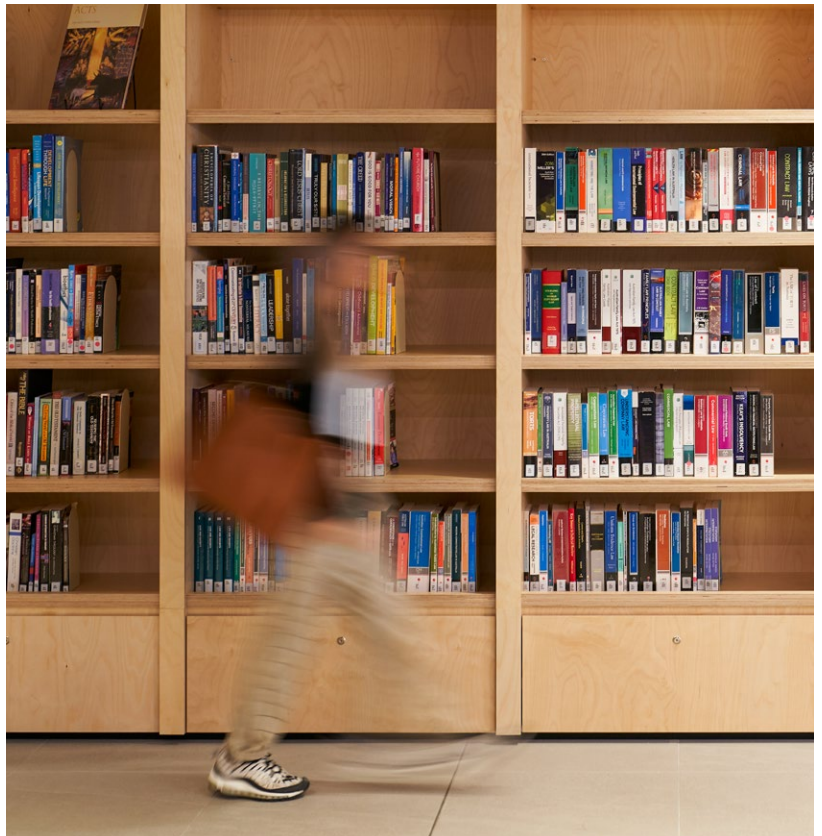
ACU's Graduate Research School is cultivating the next generation of researchers to address the critical challenges we face in the world today.

Postgraduate study

Postgraduate study generally falls into two main categories: coursework degrees and research degrees.



Coursework degrees

- Postgraduate coursework is ideal for gaining new skills and advancing your career.
- Programs can range from six-months to two years full-time (or the part-time equivalent).
- Expect a mix of classes (including online classes), units and set assessments, much like an undergraduate degree.
- Generally, an undergraduate degree is required to apply; however, in some cases, professional experience will also be considered.
- The graduate certificate, graduate diploma, and master's degree are interconnected and can be pursued progressively.
- If you're aiming for a master's degree but don't initially meet the requirements, you may be accepted into the graduate certificate or diploma in the same area of study.
- If you begin a master's degree but your circumstances change, you might be able to exit early with a graduate certificate or diploma.

Recognition of prior learning

If you're studying a postgraduate coursework degree at another university and would like to switch to ACU, or you have relevant knowledge and skills acquired in the workplace, you may be able to get credit towards your degree.

Postgraduate research degrees

As a research candidate at ACU, you will join an active and engaged community dedicated to addressing today's critical global challenges. You'll learn and apply advanced research methodologies, tackle intellectual and practical problems, and build skills that expand your career and future opportunities.

- A research degree can open doors to a wide range of career paths both within and beyond academia.
- ACU research candidates have opportunities to collaborate with businesses, government, not-for-profits and community organisations to achieve innovative results with global impact.
- You will conduct independent research and explore original ideas under the guidance of a supervisory team.
- To apply, you must meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the Higher Degree Research regulations at policy.acu.edu.au/research-regulations
- Programs are typically two to three years full-time (or equivalent part-time).

Pathway to a research degree

Honours degrees are one-year degrees for high-achieving students who have already completed a bachelor's degree, allowing candidates to build upon their knowledge, develop research skills, and work closely with academic experts. The chief focus of the degree is to produce a research thesis under supervision of an experienced academic. Some four-year bachelor's programs have honours programs embedded into their third and fourth years.

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

There are various other pathway programs that provide the required research training to enable students who have not completed honours degrees or master's by research to qualify for admission into a Higher Degree Research program. Visit acu.edu.au/research-how-to-apply

Fees and Scholarships

There are plenty of options to help you manage the cost of study. Tuition fees depend on the course you enrol in. Postgraduate coursework students have two placement types: a fee-paying place or a Commonwealth supported place (CSP). CSPs are available for many of our coursework degrees, which makes it more affordable for you to study. For research degrees, scholarships are available to support domestic and international students, covering living expenses, tuition fees, health insurance, and relocation costs.

FEE-PAYING PLACE

A fee-paying place is not subsidised by the government, so you pay the full cost of the course. As a domestic fee-paying student, you may be eligible to defer payment of your fees through the FEE-HELP government loan scheme. Repayment of the loan occurs through the tax system once your income exceeds the minimum threshold. Your employer may also consider assisting with the cost of study if the course is related to your current position.

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACE (CSP)

A wide range of postgraduate courses at ACU offer CSPs, where the government pays a proportion of tuition costs. The remainder of the fees are paid by the student, but eligible students can defer their payment through the HECS-HELP government loan scheme. Repayment of the loan occurs through the tax system once your income exceeds the minimum threshold. Domestic students who have received an offer of admission to a CSP-eligible postgraduate program are automatically considered prior to commencement each semester.

We offer competitive stipend scholarships to domestic and international students to help fund your living costs during your research degree, and reward outstanding academic achievement. Scholarships are available to support Indigenous Australians to undertake a research doctorate or research master's degree. International students who apply for a stipend scholarship may be considered for an ACU Tuition Fee Scholarship and Overseas Student Healthcare Cover.
